PROJECT BACKGROUND

In 1999, Brandenburg was retained by Pennsylvania Power & Light Company (PP&L) to decommission their Holtwood Steam Electric Station, located on the Susquehanna River.



SCOPE OF WORK

Engineered a detailed specification including all utility, environmental, and dismantling work to be performed

Developed and maintained a site-specific Health & Safety Program as well as site security

Removed Units 15, 16, and 17 consisting of four coal-fired boilers, three turbine generators, and all associated equipment

Removed a coal preparation plant, an office, service building, a water treatment plant, sewage treatment plant, other miscellaneous structures, and perform site work

Recovered and dismantled a submerged barge

Prepared all necessary permits

Performed required utility disconnections

Removed, segregated, packaged, loaded, & disposed of all waste streams

Removed and marketed all salvageable equipment

Purchased, segregated, prepared, and marketed all scrap metals
