PROJECT BACKGROUND

In 1999, Brandenburg was retained by Pennsylvania Power & Light Company (PP&L) to decommission their Holtwood Steam Electric Station, located on the Susquehanna River.

SCOPE OF WORK

Engineered a detailed specification including all utility, environmental, and dismantling work that was to be performed

Developed and maintained a site-specific Health & Safety Program as well as site security

Removed Units 15, 16, and 17 consisting of four coal fired boilers, three turbine generators, and all associated equipment

Removed a coal preparation plant

Removed an office and service building

Removed a water treatment plant and a sewage treatment plant

Recovered and dismantled a submerged barge

Removed other miscellaneous structures and perform site work

Prepared all necessary permits

Performed all required utility disconnections

Removed, segregated, packaged, loaded, and disposed of all waste streams

Removed and marketed all salvageable equipment

Purchased, segregated, prepared, and marketed all scrap metals
